OCTOBER 11 - FEASTDAY OF A NEWLY CANONIZED SAINT, POPE JOHN XXIII Pope John XXIII

(25 November 1881 – 3 June 1963) reigned as Pope from October 28, 1958 to his death on June 3, 1963. He was canonized on 27 April 2014. Angelo Giuseppe Roncalli was ordained a priest on August 10, 1904. Roncalli was elected pope on 28 October 28,1958 at the age 76. His selection was unexpected, and Roncalli himself had come to Rome with a return train ticket to Venice. He remarked "Here I am at the end of the road and the top of the heap!

Pope John XXIII surprised those who expected him to be caretaker pope by calling the historic <u>Second Vatica</u> <u>Council</u> (1962–1965). His passionate views on equali were summed up in his famous statement, "We were a made in God's image, and thus, we are all Godly alike." H also left us with his famous encyclical, PACEM IN TERRI (PEACE ON EARTH). The Church celebrates his feaday on October 11, the day of the first session of th Second Vatican Council that he had convened.
